The Enrolled Nurse (EN) working within his/her scope of clinical practice is responsible for the delivery of high quality, patient care in a variety of clinical settings.

Clinical skills and knowledge will reflect the level of training, any additional clinical 'endorsements' (medication administration/ advanced clinical skills training) and the years/ level of experience in everyday work practice.

Enrolled Nurses that are not qualified to administer medications will have the notation, "does not hold board approved qualifications in the administration of medicines" on the register against their name. At ERH this will be identified by (R) on the nurses ID badge.
