# On behalf of the ERH Board & CEO Michael Delahunty

Both past and present members of our Board of Management have worked tirelessly for the past 20 years to have the Echuca hospital expanded and rebuilt. ERH staff are also to be commended for their involvement in the lengthy planning process and together with the significant support ERH has received from our community, we will move into the first stage of our new hospital redevelopment on 17 July 2014.

In early 2010 our community banded together and developed a campaign that attracted media and political attention to the urgent need to redevelop the Echuca hospital. This very effective campaign culminated in a community rally of 1600 people in the hospital grounds in October 2010 to emphasise our desperate need for a new hospital.

In November 2010 we had our first break through. Our local member Paul Weller was instrumental in obtaining a commitment from the Coalition Government, should they be elected, of \$40 million to rebuild our hospital. Two weeks later the Coalition was elected and we continue to be indebted to Paul for securing that commitment.

In 2011 both the Federal and State budgets allocated a total of \$65.6 million to redevelop Echuca hospital. We would like to thank both Dr Denis Naphthine MP, Premier of Victoria and David Davis MP, Minister for Health and Ageing for funding the redevelopment in their first budget.

On or about 1 August 2014 building contractors Hansen Yuncken will commence demolition of our current ward areas,

together with the area currently occupied by radiology services. Once the demolition process has been completed works can then commence on stage two of the redevelopment including a new front entrance and emergency department to be located in Service Street.

It has been a magnificent team effort and we are all very excited about what this new hospital means for the future of our health service. We can be assured that this new hospital has been built to cater for both the current and future needs of our community.

Stage one of the \$65.6 million Echuca Regional Health redevelopment was opened by Premier Dr Denis Naphthine and Minister for Health David Davis. Forming part of the Victorian Coalition Government’s \$4.5 billion health infrastructure program to build a healthier community, the investment delivers a 21st century, high quality health facility for the region.

Dr Naphthine said the opening of the new Echuca hospital stage one was a major milestone in the hospital's 130 year history of delivering care to communities along the Murray River.

“The redevelopment of Echuca Regional Health is an important project that will deliver 21st century healthcare facilities for the local community well into the future” Dr Naphthine said. “With the completion of stage one, the 40,000 people living in this area now have access to a new 30 bed surgical ward, which also has specific beds for high dependency and cardiac patients, plus a 24 bed sub-acute ward”.

“Stage one also includes new medical imaging facilities and midwifery beds. With the completion of this part of the project, the focus will now be on stage two which is expected to be complete in July 2015” Dr Naphthine said.

Mr Davis said the completion of stage two will further revolutionise the delivery of health services in the region. “Focus now moves onto the second stage of works that will include the expanded emergency department, a six bed short stay medical assessment and procedure unit and upgrades to maternity services” Mr Davis said.

“Stage two works will also see the construction of a pharmacy, café, spiritual space, landscaping and new front entry making it easier for patients and families to access the hospital”.

# ERH - more than just a hospital

Echuca Regional Health was first established in 1882.

Today the health service comprises a 24 / 7 / 365 emergency department, acute hospital, residential aged care facility and provides an extensive range of primary and continuing services to meet the health needs of an estimated 44,000 people.

The health service has an operating budget of \$49 million and a staff base of 541, representing 365.8 equivalent full time staff making our local hospital Echuca Moama's largest employer.

# STAGE ONE

## -What does it offer?

**Francis Street remains the main entrance to the hospital**

Access to:

- Emergency department;
- Ward areas;
- Admissions;
- Operating theatre and day surgery unit; and
- Pharmacy

will continue through the Francis Street entrance prior to the opening of stage two in September 2015.

**Access to x-ray/radiology will change**

The only change to access will be for members of the public seeking radiology services. Echuca Radiology can now be accessed via Service Street.

**Plenty of free parking available**

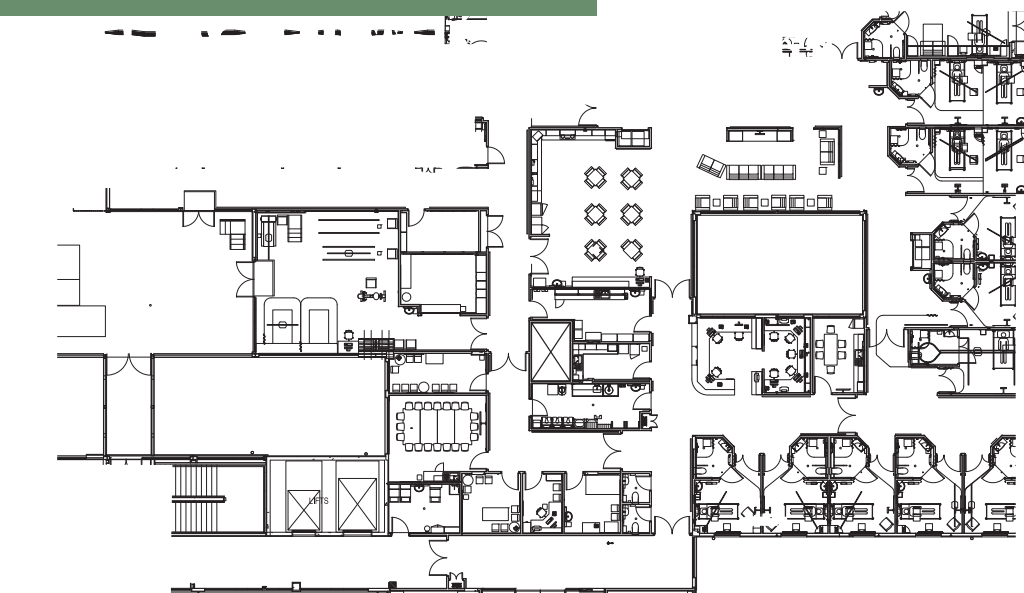
Additional car parking is now available for patients, visitors and staff.

Approximately half of the new ERH car park is now open to the public providing an

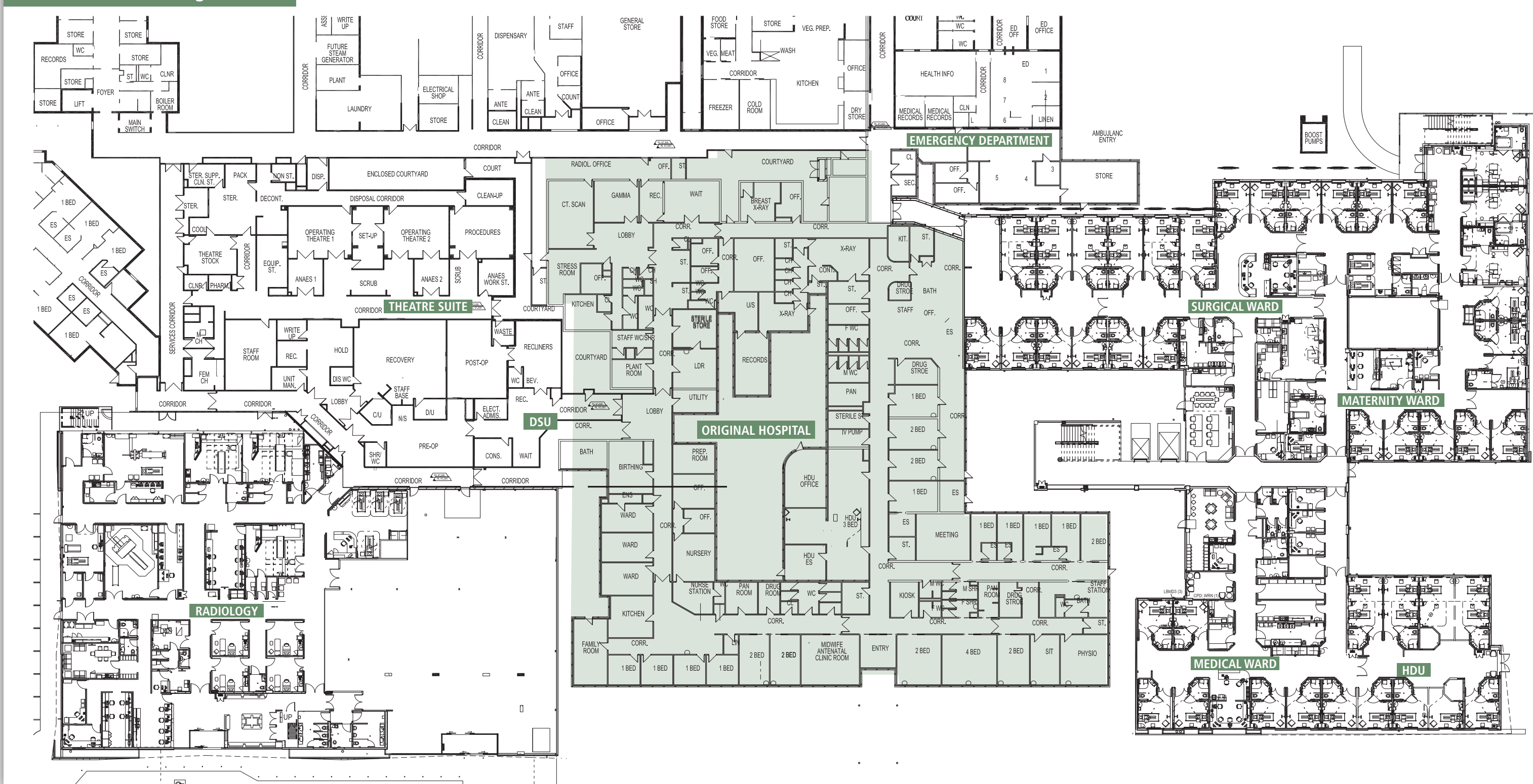
additional 70 parking spaces. Access to the car park can be obtained via a temporary entrance in High Street. Patients, visitors and staff are encouraged to utilise the new facility, leaving the car parking spaces situated closer to the hospital for those who have ambulatory difficulties.

The remaining section of the car park has been dedicated to contractor use during the period of the redevelopment.

Each room has its own computer which provides clinicians with easy access to patient medical records, encourages better communication between staff and allows the opportunity for patients to be involved in their care plans.



**Electronic buzzers** will be a thing of the past. Every patient will be able to communicate verbally with nurses via an electronic call system when they are in need of assistance.



**Landscaping** plays an essential role to improve recovery times for patients. Gardens, lawns, an atrium and courtyards contain a mass of greenery carefully selected to tolerate the Echuca Moama climate and allows patients and visitors with a welcome escape from the hospital environment.



**Paved walkways** will soon be scattered with welcome seating for patients and visitors to enjoy a breath of fresh air.

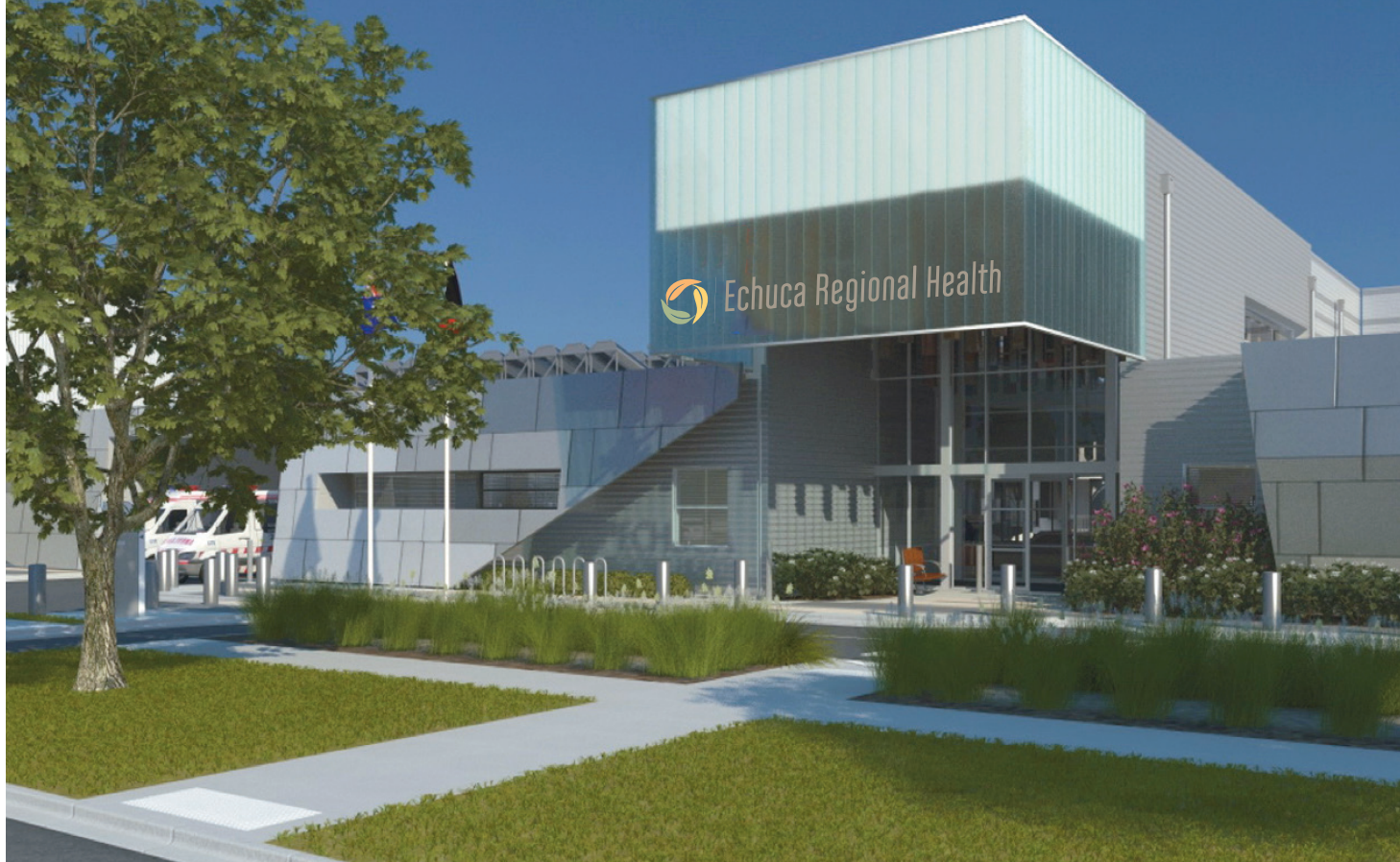

# Caring for our environment

A host of design features in the new hospital will not only improve patient comfort, they will also improve energy efficiency.

- Triple glazing to all bedroom windows with electric integrated venetian blinds;
- Double glazing and tinting to all other windows to assist in the reduction of loss of heating and cooling;
- A ducting design system which has achieved a 50% reduction in air loss resulting in significant energy savings;
- Roof top solar field providing energy for heating and cooling resulting in ERH achieving the lowest energy footprint per square metre for any hospital in Victoria;
- All storm water piping is made from recycled milk cartons;
- Irrigation water is recycled;
- The medical ward area has a concrete roof to allow for future proofing;
- Corridors contain strip lighting to reduce glare for patients which dim automatically at 6.00 pm daily.



## What's still to come in stage two?

- **A new front entrance** – located in Service Street.
- **Emergency Department** – an increase from 7 to 15 treatment cubicles; and six short stay beds.
- **Patient bed capacity will be 114 compared to 68 currently** – a 70% increase overall.



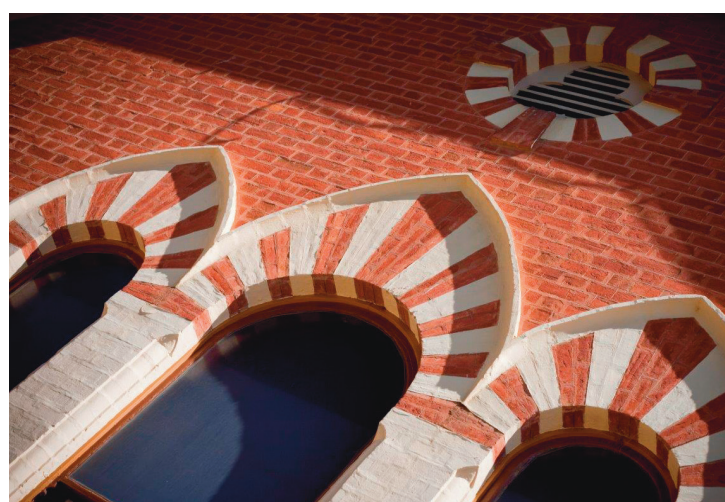
# Navigating your way around the hospital
